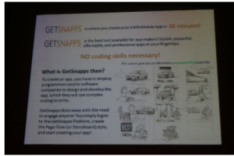

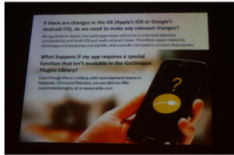

To help you get started we offer 30 plugins and 23 page templates at your disposal. You can request for new plugins or templates as well for a fee, and your custom plugins and templates will be accessible to you only. Even after your app has been published, you are still free to make changes, whatever they may be and wherever you need to.

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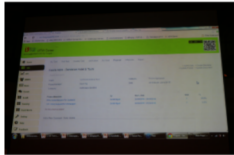
Some of the features of M3 Tech's GetSnaps.



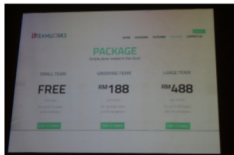

On the other hand, the i3TeamWorks is the ideal tool for those of you who cannot resist the idea of micromanaging. Dubbed by M3 Tech as the best in "Business Management Solution," it's a Web-based software suite coming with everything a business needs, from setting and keeping track of KPIs, and built-in tools to get employees to report regularly to their superiors.



Some of the features of i3TeamWorks.

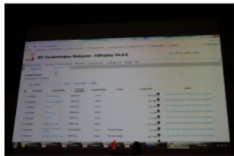


i3Display. It's actually easier to use than you think.

Inside and outside of the organization building, employees can report on their location and actions in completing project milestones to superiors. i3TeamWorks can also be used to turn meeting minutes to task lists to be assigned to the appropriate employee nearly instantaneously. Mixed tasks will also be identified and tracked, allowing management personnel to take appropriate rectifying measures, if needed. It can also take human resource tasks such as attendance management for personnel on the field to report their current location by using their mobile phones to click in their attendance. Of course, this requires said mobile device's location services to be on.



The i3Display is the only piece of hardware on the list, and it runs on Android. No, it's not a phone. What it is, though, is something better described as a kiosk. The display panel is an LCD screen with infrared touch sensors, and it can come in various configurations to meet the needs of your business. You could even have it on a floor stand or wall mounted.



The i3Display is simple, and you get an interface for i3Display to manage.

Database management is done via a user-friendly Content Management System (CMS), and is accessed online, so you can access any of the panels from anywhere and at any time you need to. Beyond content delivery, it also keeps track of engagement figures, recording the number of times the touch sensor was triggered with, for you to keep track of the effectiveness of the material displayed on the i3Display.
